We are inviting you to participate in our summer Tide Me Over program to help families from Smith & Heritage Elementary Schools who participated in our school-year Tide Me Over backpack program. Each family in the program is eligible to pick up groceries weekly through August 25. Examples of items that may be included are macaroni and cheese, peanut butter, tuna fish, hotdogs or hamburger, canned goods, bread, produce, and cereal. Families could pick up their groceries at Outreach during our open hours (listed above on the right). Enclosed is a punch card for each family in our program that you would use each week to pick up your groceries—just show the card and someone will punch it and hand you groceries for your family—no forms to fill out! We hope this new program helps fill any “food gap” your family may experience. Also included with this letter is a survey about the school-year Tide Me Over Backpack program. We would love to get your feedback, so if you could take a few moments to fill it out and then return it to us in the enclosed self-addressed, stamped envelope, we would really appreciate it!
